
## **Removal Procedure**

**Caution:** Refer to Battery Disconnect Caution in the Preface section.

**Caution:** Refer to <u>SIR Caution</u> in the Preface section.

**Important:** Make sure to move the seat to the forward position to allow access to the retaining nuts.

- 1. Disconnect the battery ground cable from the battery. Refer to <u>Battery Negative Cable Disconnection and Connection</u>.
- 2. Disable the SIR system. Refer to SIR Disabling and Enabling.
- 3. Remove the front seat. Refer to Front Seat Replacement Bucket.
- 4. Remove the seat cushion outer trim panel. Refer to <u>Seat Cushion Outer Trim Panel</u> Replacement.
- 5. If required, remove the seat-belt buckle. Refer to Front Seat Belt Buckle Replacement.






- 6. Remove the four seat adjuster retaining nuts (2) attaching the seat adjuster assembly (1) to the seat cushion frame.




8. As required, detach the electrical wiring harness connectors (1).






2. Install the four seat adjuster retaining nuts (2) attaching the seat adjuster assembly (1) to the seat cushion frame.


**Tighten** 

Tighten the retaining nuts to 42 N⋅m (31 lb ft).

  - Route pretensioner cable under cable tray tabs (1)
  - Direct pretensioner cable through cable tray gap (2)
  - Clip to under side of cable tray in the top hole (3)
